Conference themes

Continuing in the tradition of previous International Outdoor Education Research Conferences, the aim of this conference is to build on the social, cultural and critical dimensions of research and theorizing in diverse outdoor traditions, including: education (both learning and teaching), recreation, place, sustainability and therapy. Therefore, there is no specialized conference theme and the conference welcomes all abstracts that broadly enhance the understanding, practice and research of outdoor studies.

Call for abstracts

Abstracts for oral and poster presentations are now being accepted for the 7th IOERC. Presentations from various disciplinary angles, across a variety of themes, are welcome from researchers, practitioners and graduate students.

Please complete the form in the enclosed Word file and submit it by email to the co-conveners (Pat Maher and Morten Asfeldt) at ioerc7@cbu.ca before the deadline of **November 1, 2015**.

All abstracts will be double-blind peer reviewed by members of the International Academic Committee or other subject-matter experts. Notification of abstract acceptance, rejection, or the need for revisions will be made by December 15, 2015. If revisions are required, those will need to be completed by January 15, 2016.

Conference Proceedings

We will be publishing a book of conference abstracts, available at the conference. These will have been peer reviewed in the process of abstract submission. In addition, in the coming months we will be discussing post-conference publication options (books and journal special issues) with a number of respected international publishers. We hope to have a number of options available and details will be shared as appropriate before and during the 7th IOERC.
